## **JOB EVALUATION – SCHOOL SUPPORT STAFF/TAs NOT EMPLOYED IN SCHOOLS – IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR ALL MEMBERS**

UNISON, with the management side and the other recognised trade unions, has been working hard to collate the information that has now been sent in, in relation to job descriptions and common roles. From the information that has been received, it has been possible to look more closely at how the detail of individuals' jobs can be collated. A proposal to develop profiles for all roles has been put forward by the management side. Individuals would comment on their own profile rather than being put into a job group covering different schools.

The trade unions believe that this could be the way forward but have said that we need to see more examples (so far a small sample has been produced by the management side covering only administrative roles). Once we have further information, we will share with our members during the workplace meetings we are holding:
