Pension Credit

Are you a couple – has one of you already reached state pension age while the other hasn't? Or is one over and one under 65?

From 15 May you will no longer be able to claim Pension Credit.

You will have to claim Universal Credit instead until you are both over state pension age and could lose around £7,000 a year. Find out more

Are you single, over state pension age and on a low income? Are you both over state pension age and on a low income?

The government says over 1 million people who should be claiming pension credit aren't – saving the government £3 billion a year.

Climate Change – what can we do....

The last 18 months have seen the issue of climate change appropriately raised to centre stage. This has not been thanks to our rulers but rather to Greta Thurnberg, the subsequent world wide school students climate strikes, the Campaign against climate change and the development of Extinction Rebellion. There have been national and worldwide protests, including several excellent protests in Nottingham, drawing attention to the crucial importance of the issue.

It is clear that time is running out with the Australian wildfires and the flooding in Jakarta making concrete the scale of the crisis. The recent abject COP25 talks in Madrid highlight the inadequate response of our government and most governments across the world, to put a stop to increasing carbon emissions. Locally, there are forthcoming activities that members, retired and otherwise can get involved in. These include the continued school Students protests on 13th March.

There have also been protests against the continued investment in fossil fuels by our (Nottinghamshire) pension fund. There was a protest of 50+ at the Pension Committee at County Hall on 20 January and a further protest regarding this matter again at County Hall on 13th February. We have invited a speaker from Extinction Rebellion to address the Branch AGM on Tuesday 24th March regards pension fund divestment from fossil fuel, something which has been UNISON National policy for 3 years. Why not come along and listen to what they have to say!

Police and Crime Commissioner Elections May 2020

The PCC elections are taking place across the country on 7th May. Retired members can help in the campaign by signing up for postal votes, if they do not already have one. Contact your local council electoral registration officer or download the form from their website. Ballot papers will be sent out in late April.

Many pensioners take holidays in the Spring, if you are going away when ballot papers come out and can't vote in person on 7th, you can apply for a proxy vote, allowing a close friend or family member to vote for you.

We would urge you to use your vote. UNISON would always look for candidates that have a strong record of defending public services. Despite Government cuts to police funding, Nottinghamshire have consistently recruited additional officers (147 this financial year). PCSO numbers have remained steady, knife crime is down by 8% in Nottinghamshire and 18% in Nottingham City. Burglary and sexual offences are also down.
